## KINDERGARTEN 2015 2ND ORIENTATION DAY

Wednesday, December 10th, 9am - 12.45pm

The timetable for this day is as follows:

9.00-9.10am	Arrive at school (be sure to bring a hat).
9.15am	Bell rings and lessons commence for the day (parents are welcome to stay as long as necessary for their child to be settled).
10.55am	Five minute fruit break in their classroom. Children should bring a piece of fruit or vegetable.
11.00am	Bell rings for a 20 minute break. Children should bring a healthy recess snack.
11.20am	Bell rings and lessons recommence.
12.20am	Children eat lunch in their classroom. Children should bring lunch and a non-sugary drink (no lollies or chewing gum permitted).
12.30pm	Bell rings for a 20 minute break.
12.45pm	Parents/caregivers should collect their pre-school children.

This kit includes our School Information Booklet, school enrolment form, bus transport form, private vehicle conveyance subsidy form (if applicable), uniform order form, plus other information for parents of children starting school next year, all contained in a calico library bag. 

# Results of Surveys

Recently, I sought your opinions and those of some students (the Primary Class) about our school. Your responses are presented below.

***Students in Years 3-6 anonymously completed a School Life Student Questionnaire which sought to find out how they felt about their life in their Primary School. The survey comprised forty questions which asked the children to 'agree', 'mostly agree', 'mostly disagree' or 'disagree'. Positive answers to 'My school is a place where...' included:***

- ⇒ My teacher is fair to me;
- ⇒ I am a success as a student;
- ⇒ I learn to get along with other people;
- ⇒ Other students accept me as I am;
- ⇒ The work is a good preparation for my future;
- ⇒ I feel happy;
- ⇒ The things I learn are important to me;
- ⇒ Things I learn will help me in secondary school;
- ⇒ I feel proud to be a student;
- ⇒ My teacher takes an interest in helping me with my work;
- ⇒ People trust me;
- ⇒ I can learn what I need to know;
- ⇒ I know I can keep up with the work
- ⇒ What I learn will be useful;
- ⇒ I get enjoyment from being there;
- ⇒ Other students are very friendly.

There were very few negative responses in the survey.

***Parents were asked to complete surveys relating to Culture, Teaching and Learning. Seven surveys were returned from twenty-four (approximately a 30% return rate). All surveys were generally positive about the school's approach to these three areas. No surveys were negative.***

In the **Culture** survey, parents responded most positively to the following statements:

- ⇒ I am proud of my child's school;
- ⇒ The school encourages everyone to learn;
- ⇒ The school encourages everyone to achieve their best.

In the **Teaching** survey, parents responded most positively to the following statements:

- ⇒ What students are asked to learn is important;
- ⇒ My child's teachers know what my child can do and what they need to learn;
- ⇒ My child's teachers keep records of his/her progress;
- ⇒ The school provides clear information about student achievement through the school's reporting process.

In the **Learning** survey, parents responded most positively to the following statements:

- ⇒ Teachers talk to me about my child's learning;
- ⇒ My child has access to good equipment that helps him/her to learn;
- ⇒ The school expects students to achieve to the best of their ability;
- ⇒ Students at the school demonstrate pride in their learning.

These findings will appear in this year's Annual School Report. Thank you to all who responded to the surveys.
