- Students took part in a Remembrance Day Ceremony on November 11th;
- The Gulaga Public Speaking Day was held with students competing from 3 other local primary schools. Central Tilba students won both divisions and the aggregate shield;
- A student teacher from Canberra has been working in our school;
- The Primary Class attended a three day excursion to Bournda EEC. The children were excellent. Thanks to Jeff, Fran and Cindy for accompanying the kids and Linda for her organising of the excursion;
