It was great meeting up again at Presentation Night yesterday to celebrate the success and achievements of our children over the year.

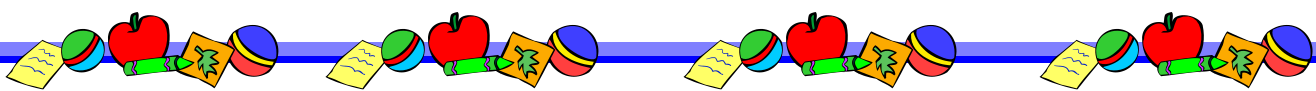
Thanks again and I look forward to more fun times working together to fundraise next year.

Year 6 2015 Sculpture



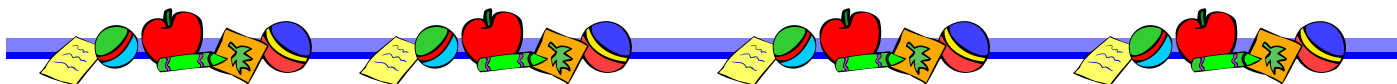


Last Day and 'We Love Our Teddies'



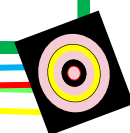

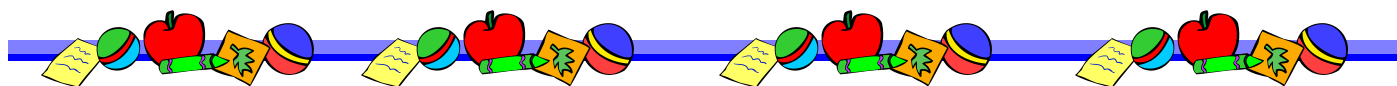
