# KINDERGARTEN 2016 ORIENTATION DAYS

The timetable for these two days is as follows:

9.00-9.10am Arrive at school (be sure to bring a hat).

9.15am Bell rings and lessons commence for the day (parents are welcome to stay as long as necessary for their child to be settled).

10.45am Five minute fruit break in their classroom. Children should bring a piece of fruit or vegetable.

11.00am Bell rings for a 20 minute break. Children should bring recess snacks and a water bottle (NO lollies, chewing gum or sugary drinks permitted).

11.20am Bell rings and lessons recommence.


# MULTILIT

# A BIG FUNDRAISER FOR OUR P&C BUNNINGS BATEMANS BAY SAUSAGE SIZZLE SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 29TH, 2015

This will be a BIG fundraiser for our P&C and School, so we hope as many parents/family/friends as possible will be able to help on the day. Bunnings require us to be there and selling sausage sandwiches from 9am to a minimum of 4pm (plus set up/pack up time). It's not a lot of effort and can be very enjoyable and rewarding.

Fundraisers like this are the reason the P&C are able to help parents and students with costs such as:

- \* *Paying for the bus that took many of our children to the Special Swimming Scheme over the last two weeks. Without this financial support from the P&C, costs to parents would have been over \$70/child more (over \$100 in total for the ten days) in which case the scheme may not have been feasible for our students to have this intensive learn to swim program.*
- \* *The Primary Class excursion to Canberra is being subsidised for every child in the class by over \$175 each. Without this financial support many students would miss out or the whole excursion may not be feasible because of small numbers. Would you be able to afford to send your child(ren) on this excursion without the P&C's help?*

We ALL lead busy lives and it's often hard to fit things in, but this is important and will save you many \$ in the 'long run'. So if you can see your way into helping for just a couple of hours, please complete the form in this newsletter and RETURN IT TO THE SCHOOL ASAP AS WE NEED TO GET A ROSTER ORGANISED and we need to know that there will be enough help to actually run the stall on the day.

## **NUMBER – Fractions and Decimals; Patterns and Algebra – YEAR FOUR**

*Please note that the information presented in this Newsletter is of a general nature. For specific information related to your child, it is recommended that you speak with your child's teacher.*

*By the end of Year Four, a child should be able to –*

### **Fractions and Decimals**

- \* *Model and find equivalence between fractions with denominators of 2, 4 and 8; 3 and 6; and 5, 10 and 100;*
- \* *Apply the place value system to represent tenths and hundredths as decimals;*
- \* *Make connections between fraction and decimal notation;*
- \* *Model, compare and represent decimals with one and two decimal places;*
- \* *Represent decimals on number lines.*

### **Patterns and Algebra**

- \* *Find missing numbers in number sentences involving addition and subtraction on one or both sides of the equal sign;*
- \* *Investigate and use the properties of odd and even numbers;*
- \* *Recognise, continue and describe number patterns resulting from performing multiplication;*
- \* *Find missing numbers in number sentences involving one operation of multiplication or division.*
