Ideas put forward:

- * **Finish nature trail with mulch and making pathway safe;**
- * **Irrigate the veggie garden;**
- * **Rabbit proof the veggie garden by replacing the netting;**
- * **Planting an orchard of fruit trees;**
- * **Adapting School Science units to accommodate activities in the school yard;**
- * **Install an outdoor weather station;**
- * **Rare plant rescue plan;**
- * **Painting stepping stones in native garden/creating a mural;**
- * **Involve the services of Cathy Thomas (National Parks), Bernadette Davis (Council), Bournda EEC and Natalie Bateman (local artist)**
- * **Pursue a grant through Landcare;**
