Dear Parents and Students,

It seems so long since the Tilba Festival! I hope everyone had a relaxing time with their children over the holiday break. Welcome back to Term Two!

I would like to thank all who were involved in the Tilba Festival on Easter Saturday. Whether you were involved in helping out on the P&C Stall, organising the children for the parade and music item or just getting your children there on time, I greatly appreciate the effort you put in on the day. Although the weather could have been better, everyone's enthusiasm was certainly not dampened.

As we begin a new term, the first event that is of significance for our school and community is the local ANZAC Day service and march this Saturday, April 25th. Information to parents on Writing

At the last P&C Meeting I outlined to parents the idea of regular articles in our School Newsletter related to Curriculum areas, giving parents an idea of how their child may be progressing based on the NSW K-6 Learning Continuums in Literacy and Numeracy. The Learning Continuums give a guideline as to where a child should be as they move from year to year.

Over the course of Term Two, I intend to provide information to parents on one of the areas in which our School Plan is focusing, that is, Writing. Each week I will outline the expectations of how a child should be faring at the end of a particular year level. This information should be considered in light of the fact that not all children perform at the same pace, and not all children necessarily achieve outcomes at the same time. Some children will be ahead of their year level, some equal with and some behind.

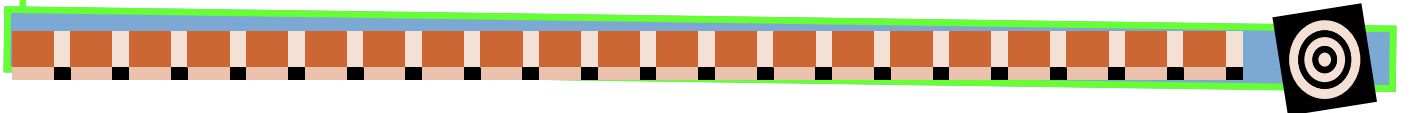
Hopefully, the information presented will provide conversation starters between parents and teachers as to the progress of each individual child.

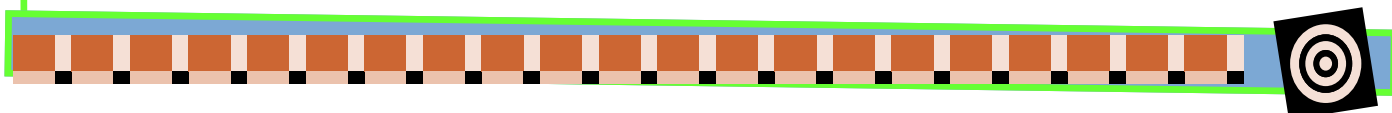

Enclosed is \$10.00 per student (or part thereof).

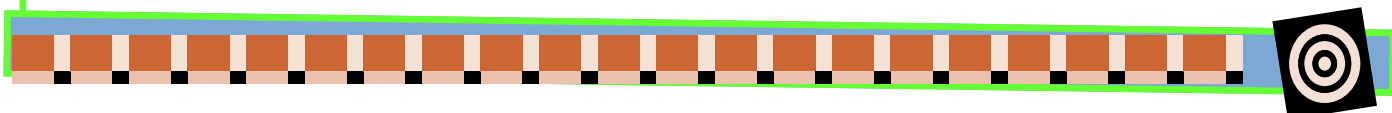
