## Numeracy Continuum

### NUMBER – YEAR TWO

*Please note that the information presented in this Newsletter is of a general nature. For specific information related to your child, it is recommended that you speak with your child's teacher.*

*By the end of Year Two, a child should be able to –*

#### WHOLE NUMBERS

- ♦ Count backwards and forwards by 2, 3, 5 and 10 from any starting point
- ♦ Partition numbers of up to 3 digits using place value
- ♦ Read, write and order 3 digit numbers
- ♦ Recognise, count and order Australian coins and notes according to their value

#### ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION

- ♦ Make connections between addition and subtraction
- ♦ Use and record a range of mental strategies for addition and subtraction of 2 digit numbers
- ♦ Solve word problems involving addition and subtraction

#### MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION

- ♦ Model and use repeated addition as a strategy for multiplication
- ♦ Model and use arrays described in terms of rows and columns as a strategy for multiplication
- ♦ Model and use groups, arrays and repeated subtraction as strategies for division
- ♦ Record using drawings, words and numerals

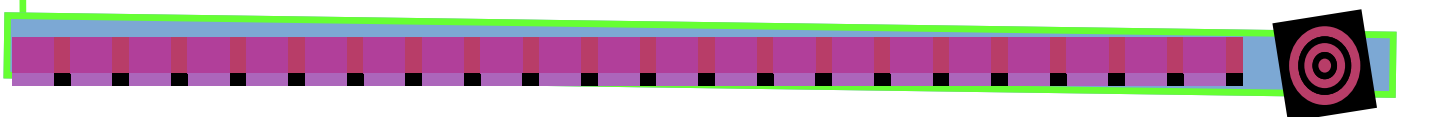

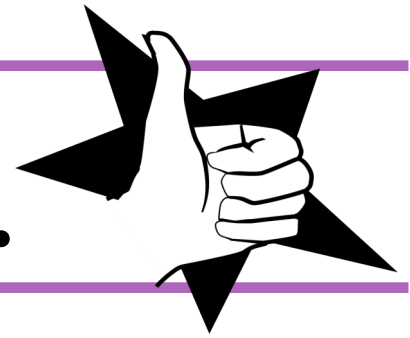

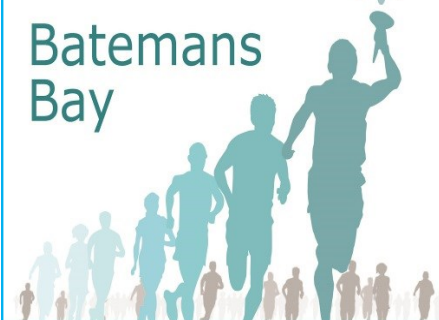


## SICK CHILDREN
