# THE PRIMARY CLASS 2016

This year the Primary Class will be taught by both myself and Mr Markham in a team teaching situation, based on my availability to be 'on class' due to the increasing external demands of my role as Principal. I will still continue to have responsibility for the programming of work for the students while Mr Markham's main curriculum areas will focus around Science and Creative Arts. Mrs Hankinson will continue to provide her expertise in Music.

Our Literacy focus this term will be on developing improved comprehension strategies in reading and developing writing skills through the use of more complex sentence structures. For spelling and reading activities, children will be grouped according to their grade and ability level. We will be using activities drawn from the 'Reading Eggspress' program, school magazines and reading boxes.

In Numeracy children will be grouped into five ability groups and will work on a different strand of mathematics each week. There will be a focus on times table recall and activities using the 'Mathletics' program.

In HSIE this term our topic is 'Cooperating Communities', looking at how people live and work together to create the goods and services necessary to survive.

Science will look at the topic 'Smooth Moves', which focuses on how objects move.

In the area of Personal Development, Health and Physical Education, children will be developing their ball skills and running skills in preparation for our Cross Country Carnival which will be held towards the end of term. We will also be forming a school soccer team to take part in the Small Schools Knockout.

## WHOOPING COUGH INFORMATION FOR SCHOOLS

There is an outbreak of whooping cough (pertussis) in NSW, mainly affecting school-aged children.

Coughing spreads the infection to others nearby. Whooping cough can spread to anyone at home, including younger brothers and sisters. Whooping cough can be especially dangerous for babies.

Whooping cough starts like a cold and progresses to bouts of coughing that can last for many weeks. The infection can occur even in fully-vaccinated children. Older children may just have a cough that is persistent and may be worse at night.

Children with these symptoms should see a doctor.

If your doctor diagnoses whooping cough in your school-aged child, please let the school know and keep your child at home until they have taken 5 days of antibiotics. Keep coughing children away from babies.

Whooping cough vaccines give good protection against infection but immunity fades with time. Check that all your children are up to date with their vaccines, due at 6 weeks, 4 months, 6 months, 4 years and 12 years of age (offered to all Year 7 students through the NSW school-based vaccination program). A booster is also recommended at 18 months of age.

A booster dose of vaccine is also recommended for adults that are in contact with young children, such as school staff and parents. Pregnant women are recommended to have a booster dose during each pregnancy and this is funded by NSW Health. Those who are new parents or carers of babies should consult their general practitioner about appropriate immunisation.
