How decision-making skills develop

Younger children are more likely to:

Focus on one aspect of a situation

Focus on their own position

Look for immediate benefits

Want things now

Act without thinking first

Make simple distinctions between good/bad, right/wrong

Make decisions based on a whim

As they develop, children are more able to:

See things from different angles

See other people's points of view

Think ahead and plan

Focus on longer range goals

Consider consequences

Apply more complex values to their own thinking

Used reasoned strategies for making decisions

By the end of Year Five, a child should be able to:

Collect categorical and numerical data by observation and by survey

- Construct data displays, including tables, column graphs, dot plots and line graphs, appropriate to the data type
- Describe and interpret data presented in tables, column graphs, dot plots and line graphs
- List outcomes of chance experiments involving equally likely outcomes
- Represent probabilities using fractions
- Recognise that probabilities range from 0 to 1


