


This week on Friday and Thursday, we did a stem activity. We built a tower. Our idea was for our towers to hold a 1kg weight.




SCIENCE 2018

2nd place was awarded to Noah, Isiah, Joey and Jack. It held 2.2kg.


3rd was Elias, Harry and riley. It held 2.1 kg.


