Hello Everyone,

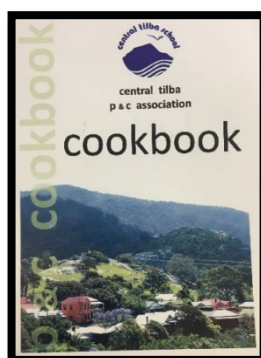
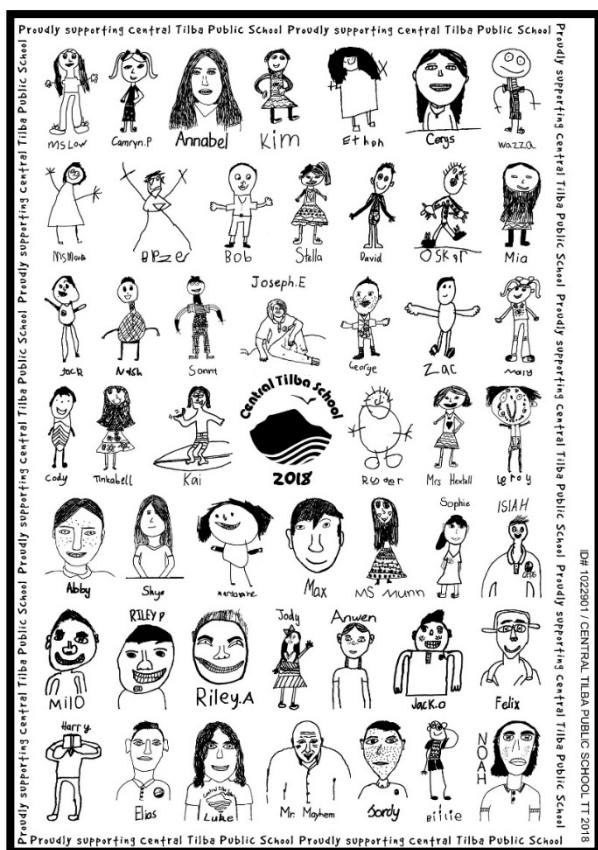
I hope you are all well and looking forward to the coming Christmas break. I would like to invite you all to the next P&C meeting on Friday 14th of December.

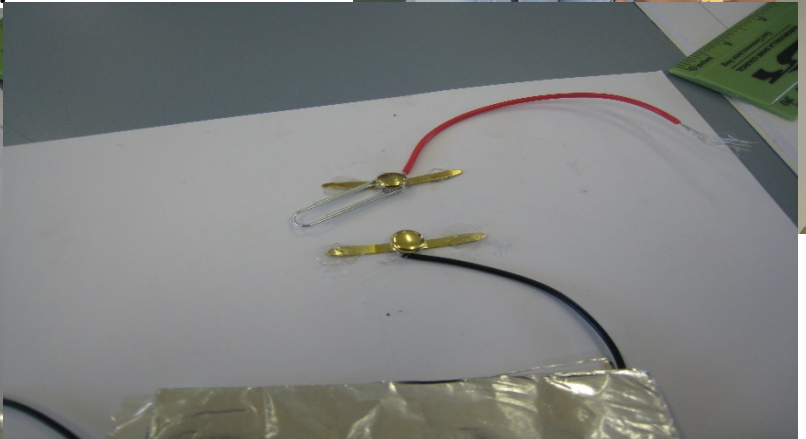
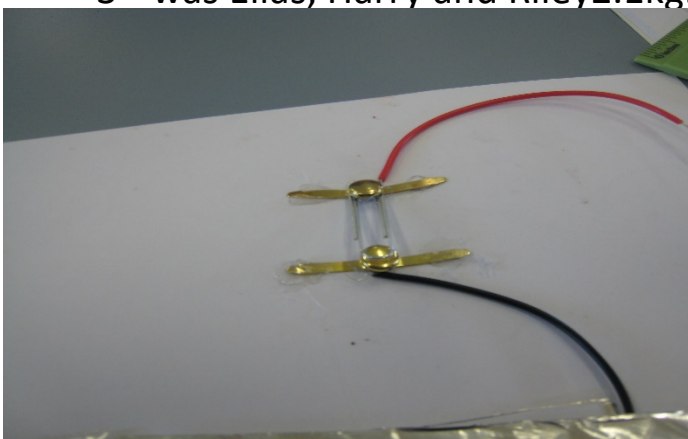
## Tower Building

2<sup>nd</sup> was Noah, Isiah, Joey, and Jack holding 2.2kg.

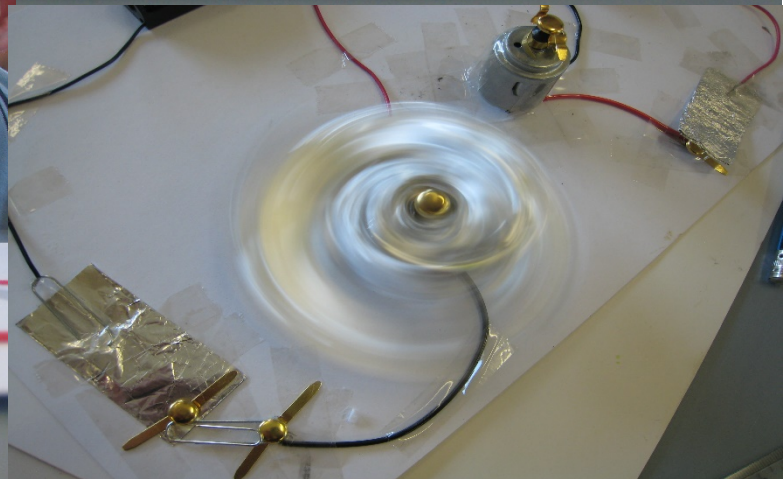
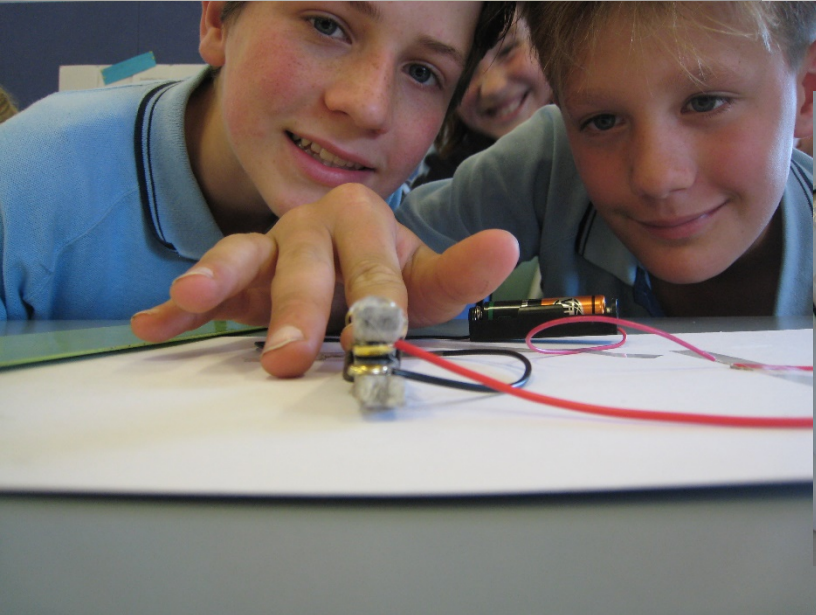
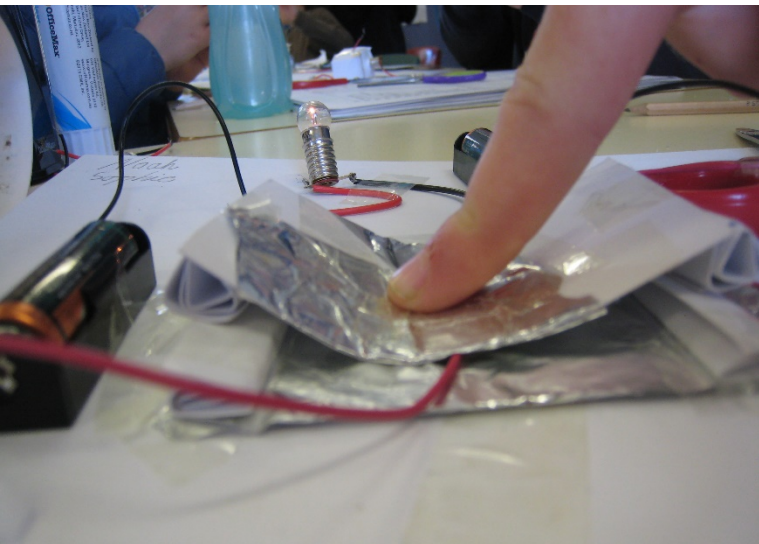

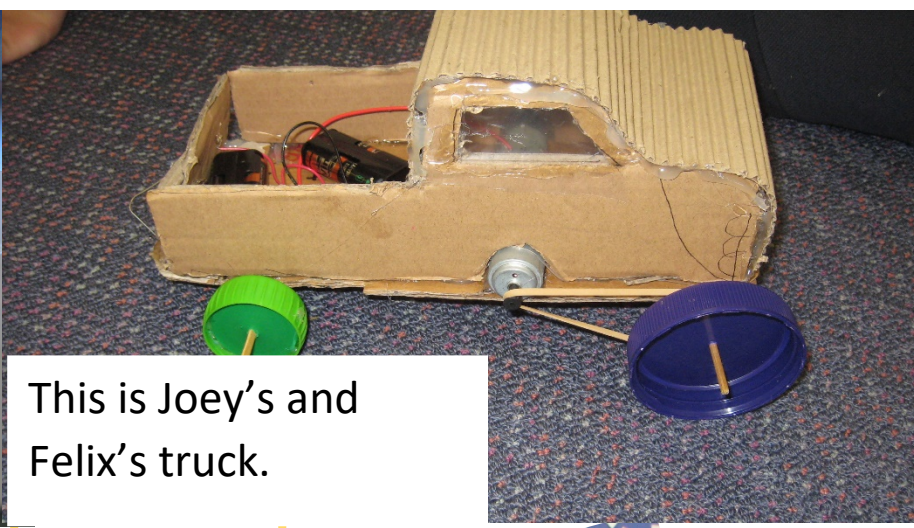
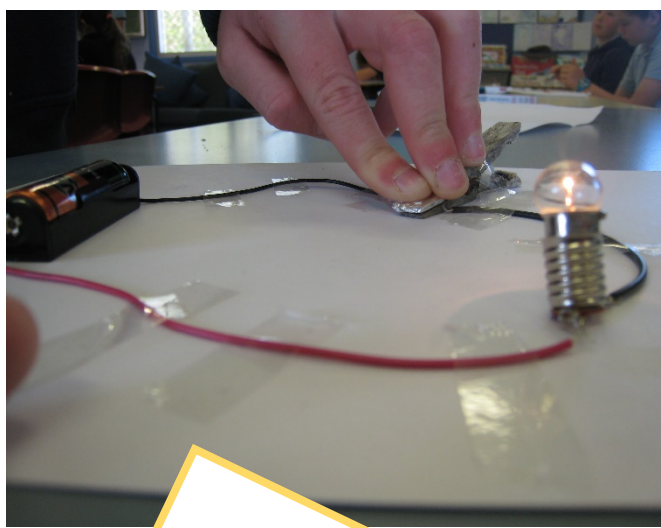


# Circuits And Switches

This year in term 3/4, we were working on science project called circuit and switches. In this lesson, we learnt how to make a circuit and how to use and make a switch.







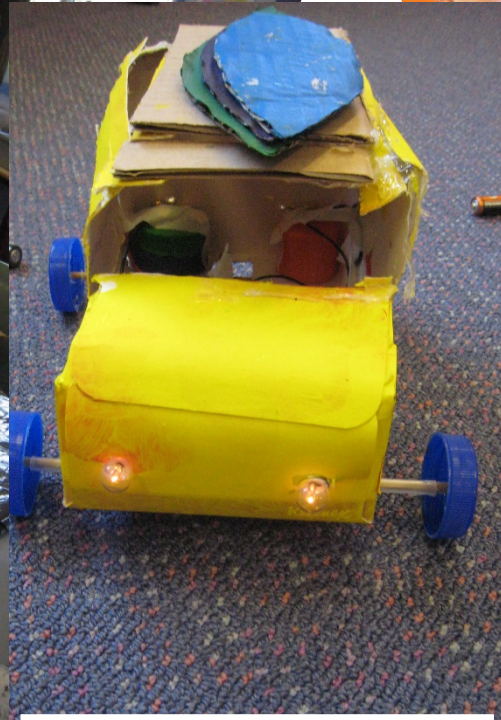

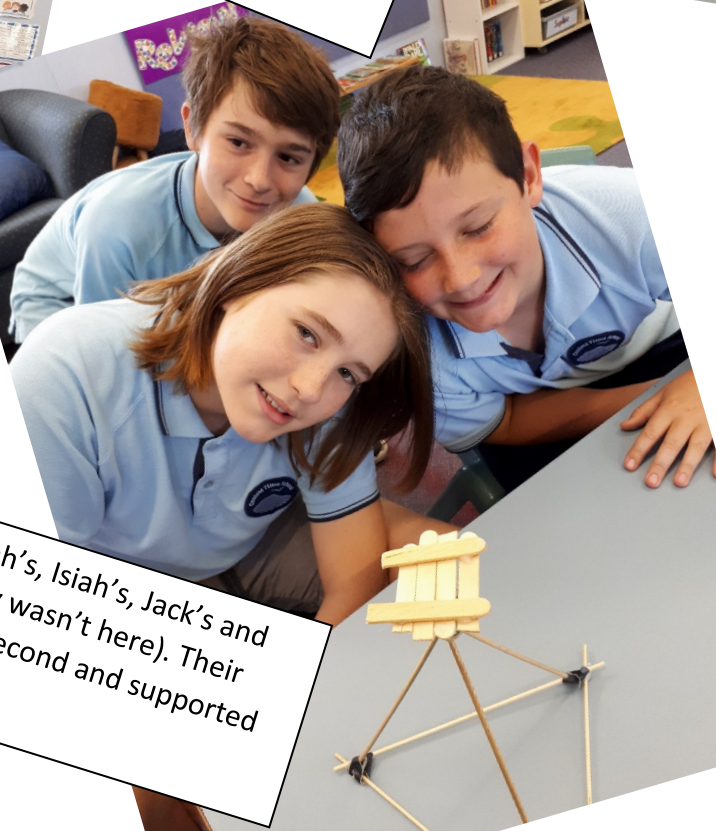
This is Felix's, Riley A's and Jordy's tower (Jordy wasn't here). Their tower held 200g.

This is Noah's, Isiah's, Jack's and Joey's (Joey wasn't here). Their tower was second and supported 2.2kg.



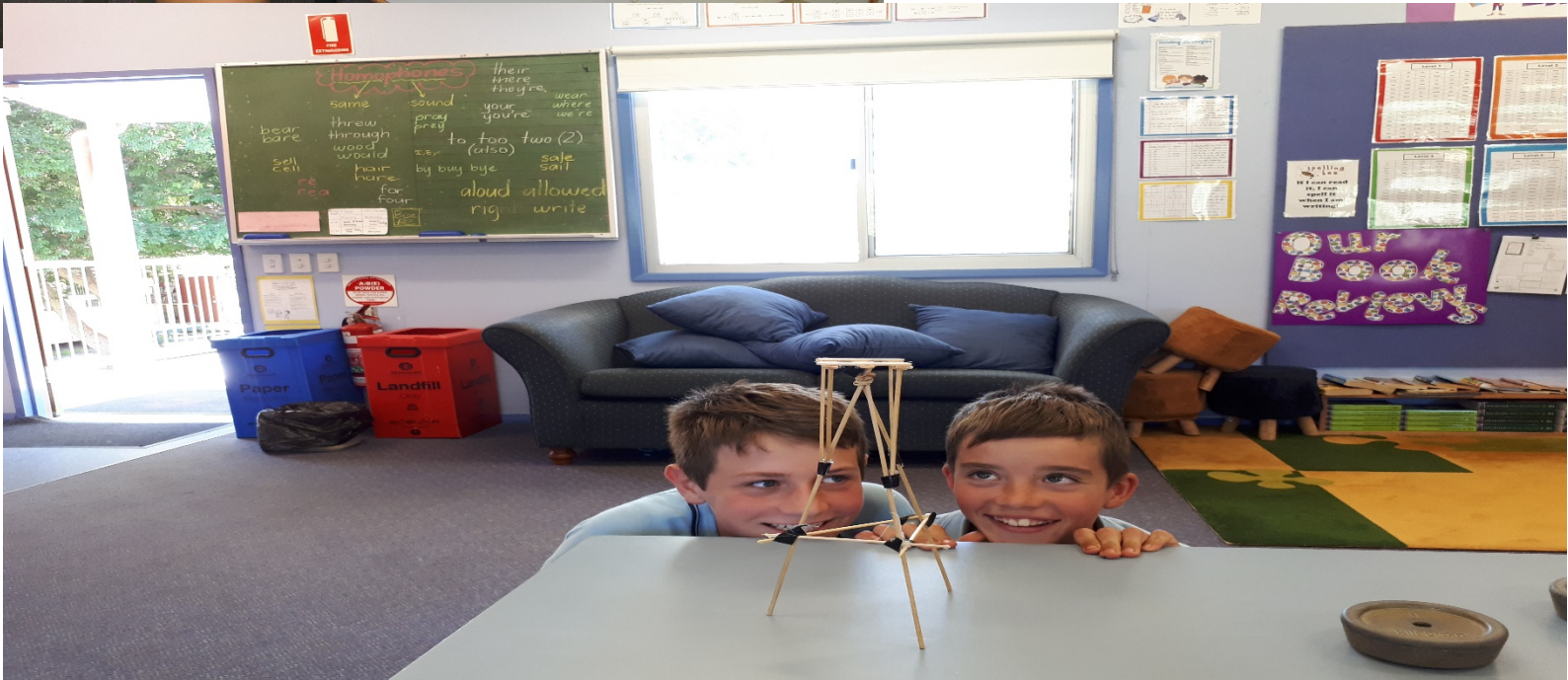
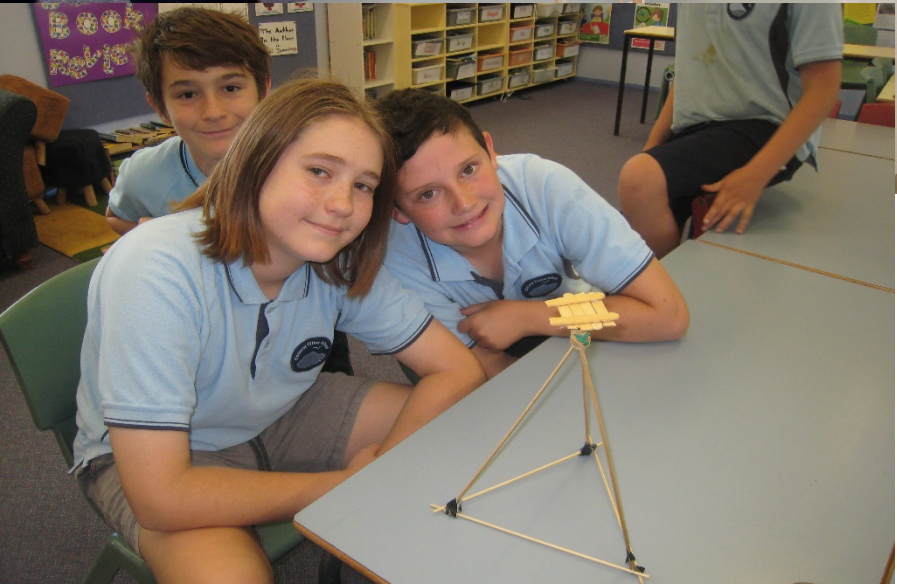

This year in science we built towers. Our aim was to make a tower that could hold 1kg. The top 3 were...

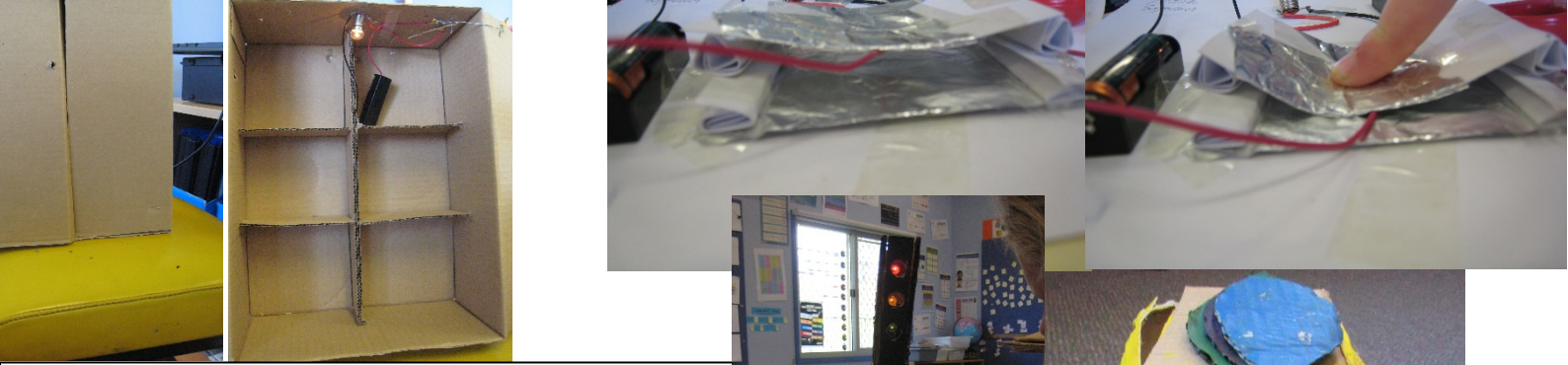

2<sup>nd</sup> place was awarded to Noah, Isiah, Joey and Jack. It held 2.2kg.

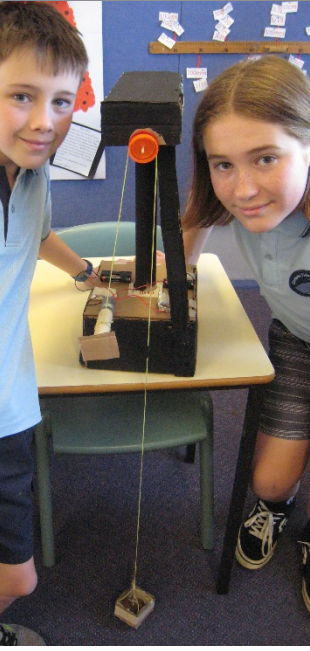
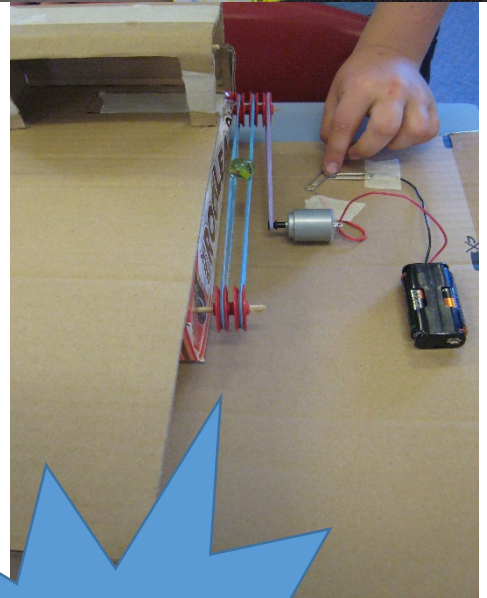
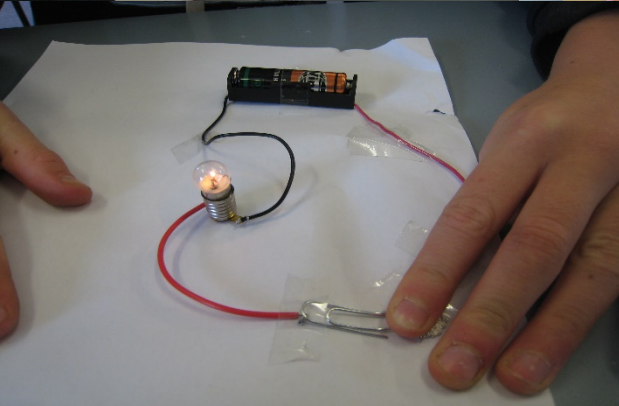
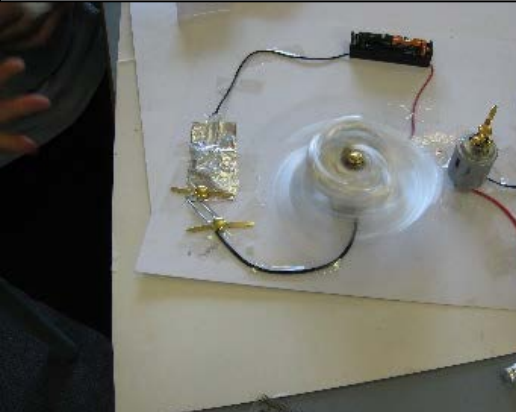
