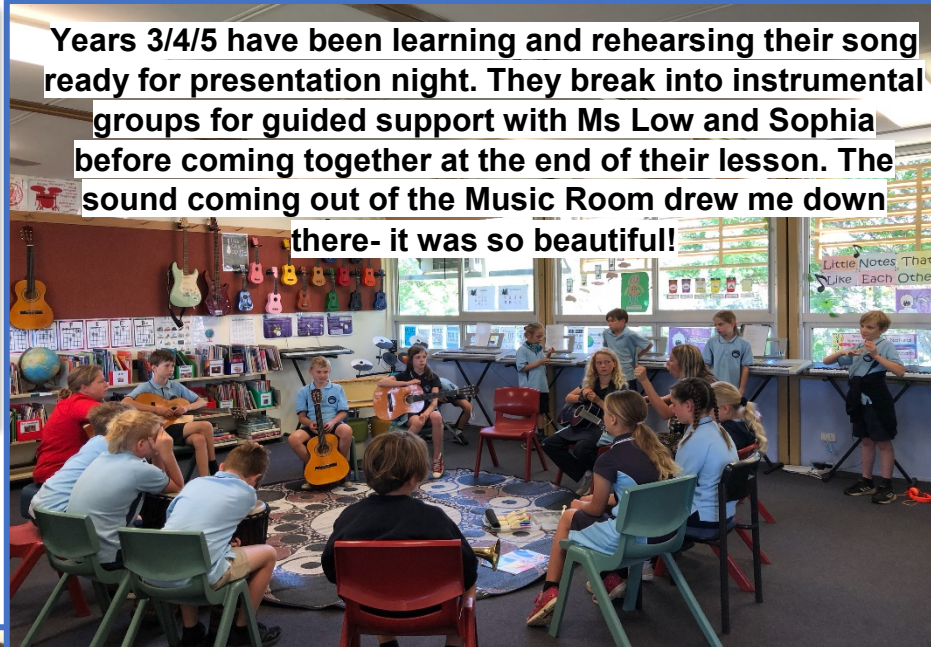
We always try to be respectful, caring and safe and we enjoy welcoming new friends to our school!

Congratulations to the children who were noticed by our school leaders this week for representing our school values in the classroom and in the playground.

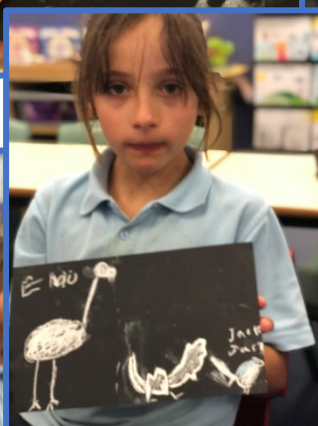
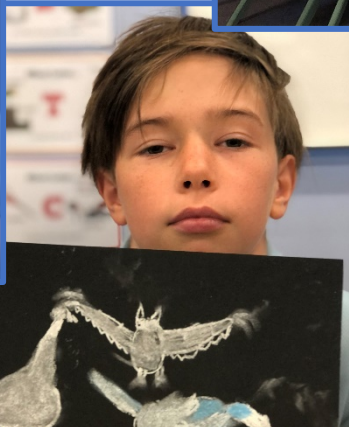

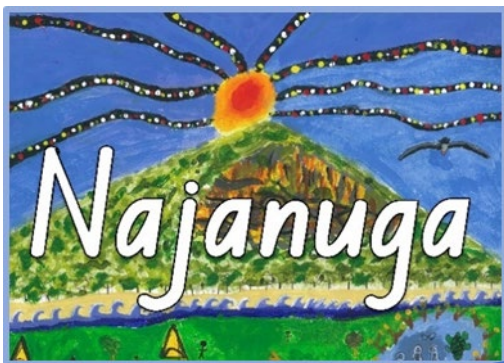
