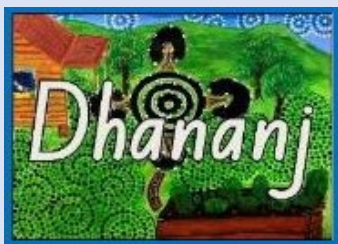

From all the staff at Central Tilba School, have a happy and safe holiday time with your families and we look forward to starting another new and productive school year with you in 2023.



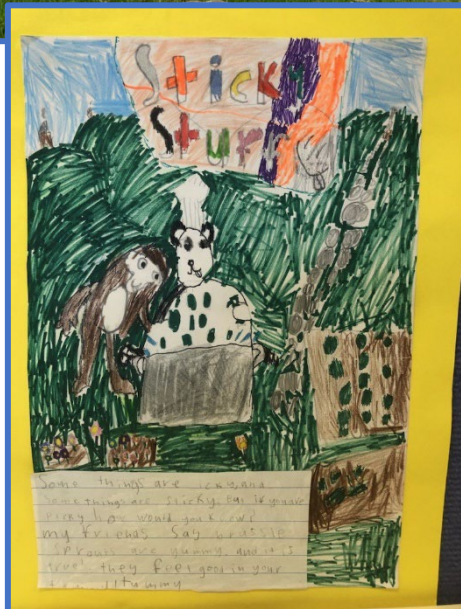


Old bossy Ossy

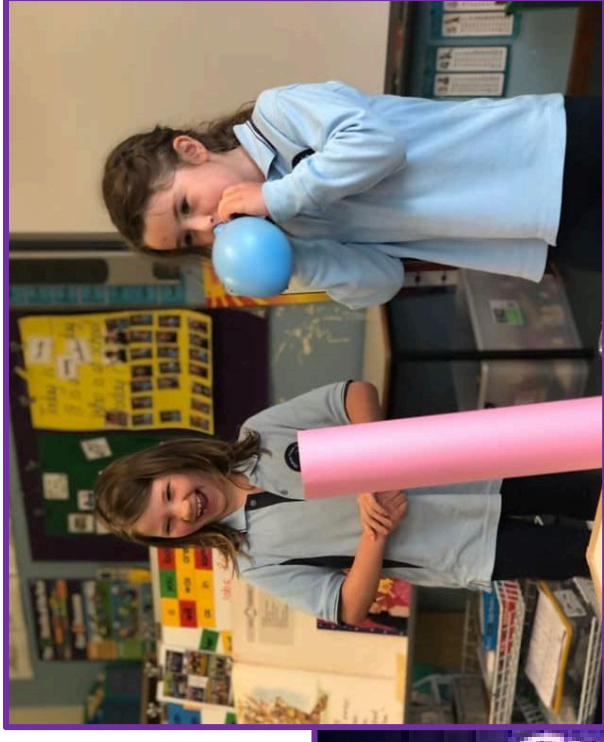
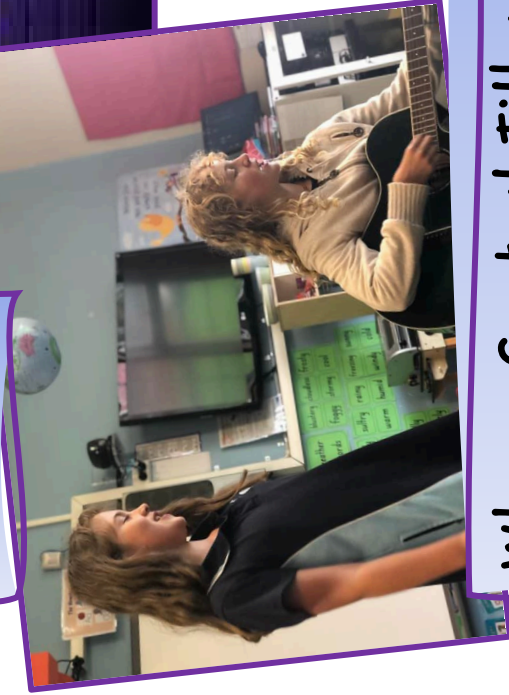

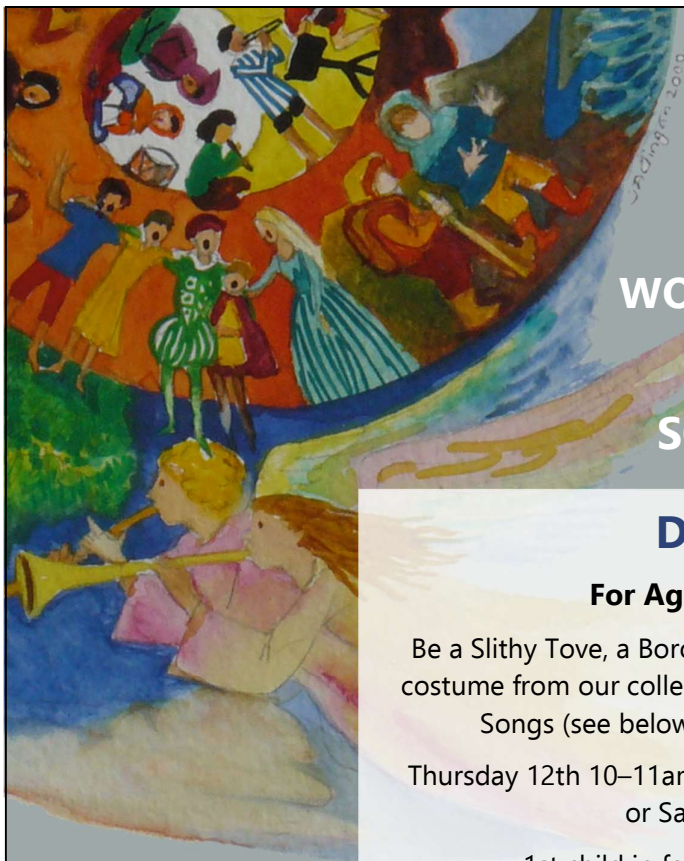
