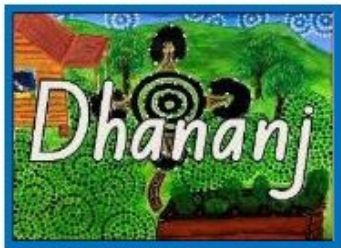

We had a virtual tour of the school using Minecraft. Sonny Jack liked the games where you used fruit for controls.



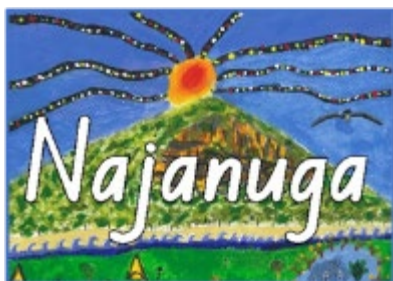
Stage 2 have been learning about the properties of angles, how to measure them and how to draw them accurately.
