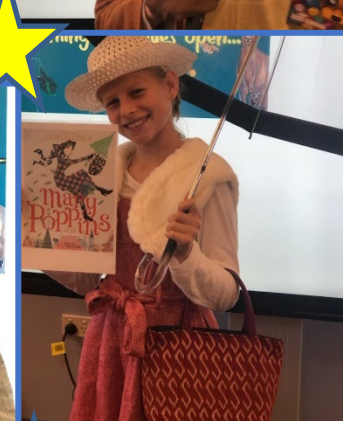
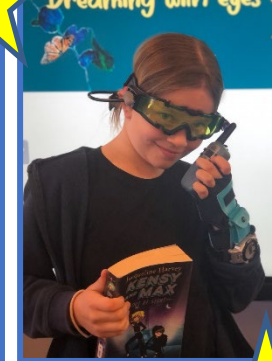
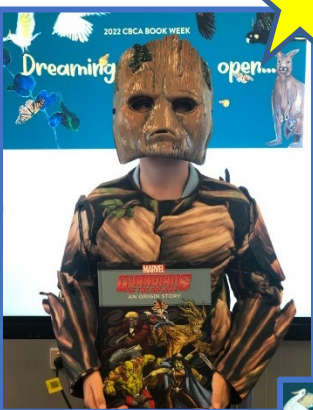
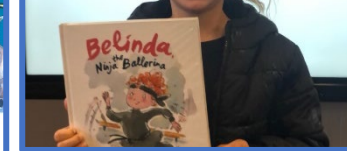
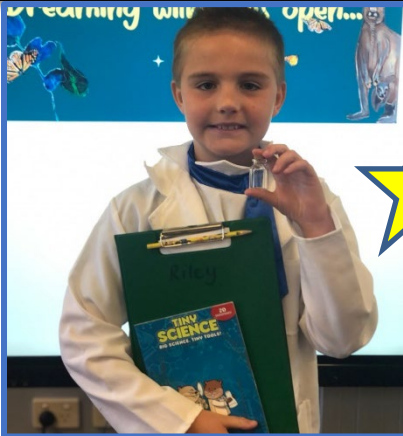
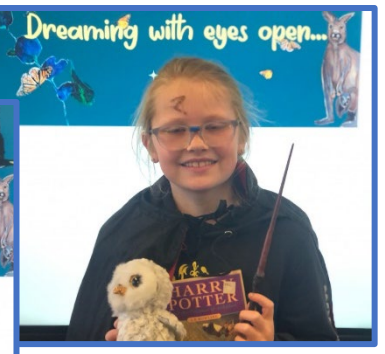
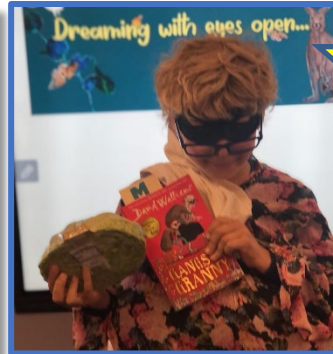
Nash, Tinkabell George and Zac are off to

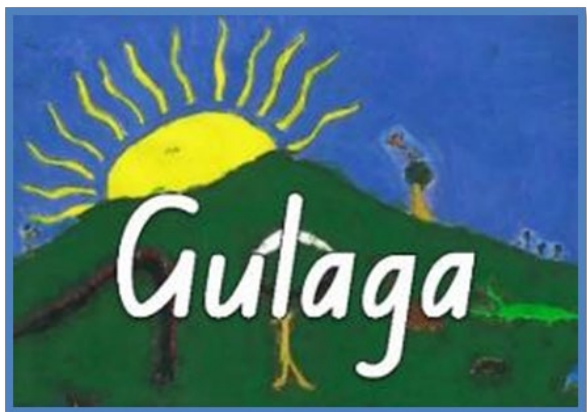
Book Week 2022
