Stage 2 explored persuasive visual elements to include in their posters.










Thank you Jack and Leroy!

Banjo, Marcus and Ethan check the images on the bird bath camera every Monday so we can upload them to iNaturalist for the Birds of a Feather program.








#### Quilba Ball Games Shield
