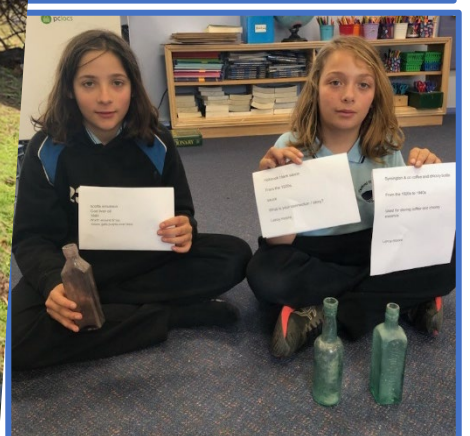
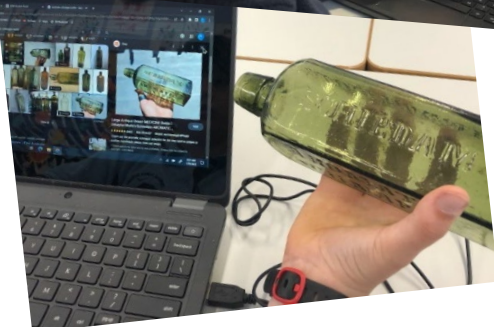
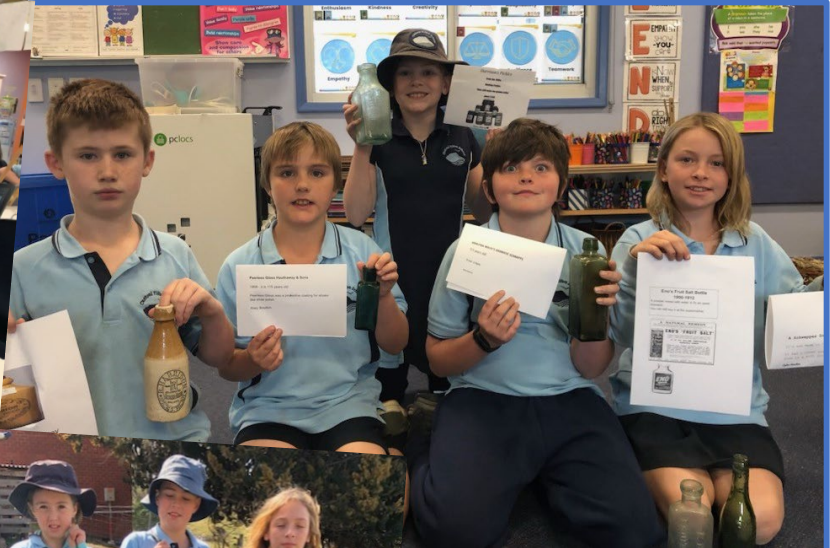
Our playground has been a busy, happy and safe place full of laughter and a variety of fun games and activities being enjoyed by all. Keep up the great work!

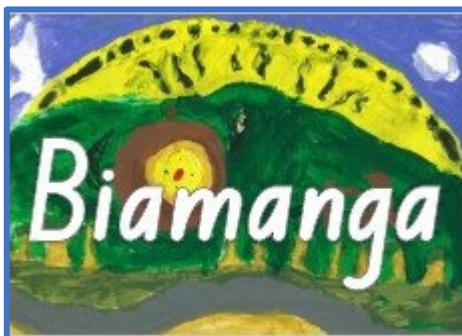

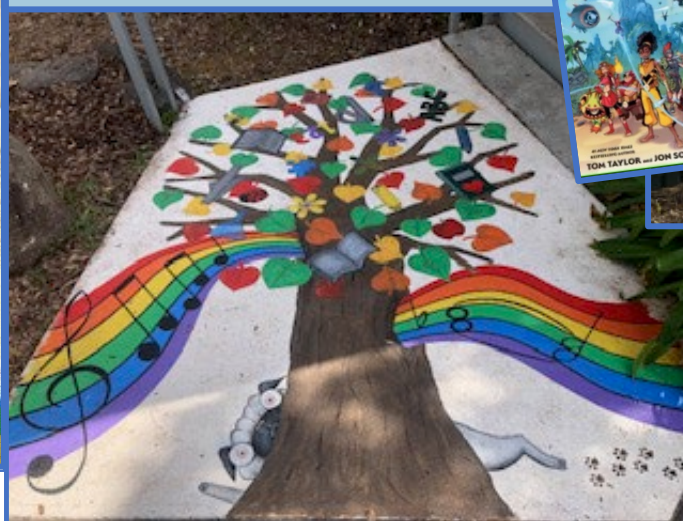


## Library

A heartwarming and hilarious tale of kindness, friendship, hurdles, hoops, see-saws ... and being yourself.

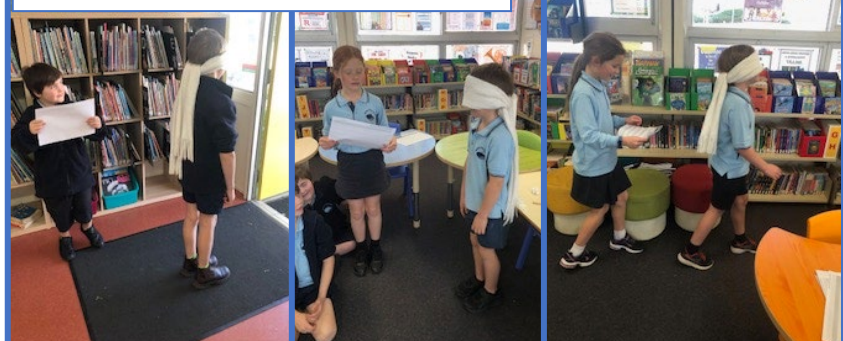
