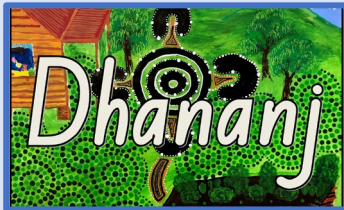

What an achievement! Today we tested post-program distances, and the impact of our weekly lessons is amazing! Thank you to all our swimming teachers x



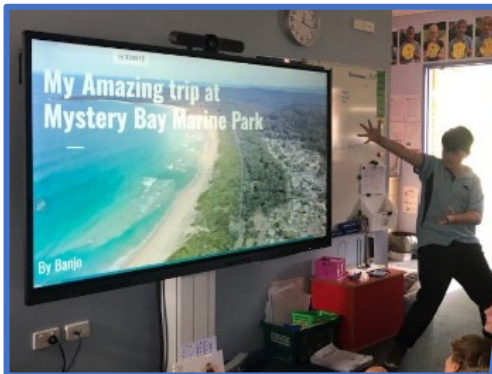

At 11 o'clock on the 11th day of the 11th month, we showed respect as we observed Remembrance Day.



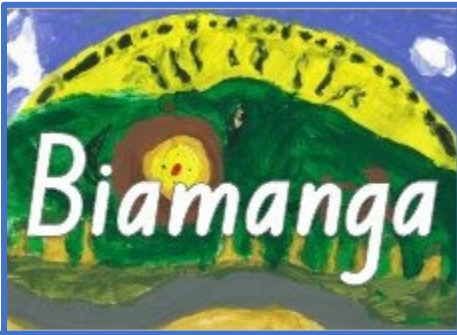
In the last minute practise sessions for our assembly item, we decided to wear caps to match the rock'n'roll theme!

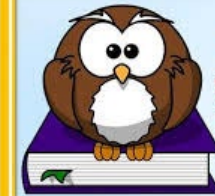

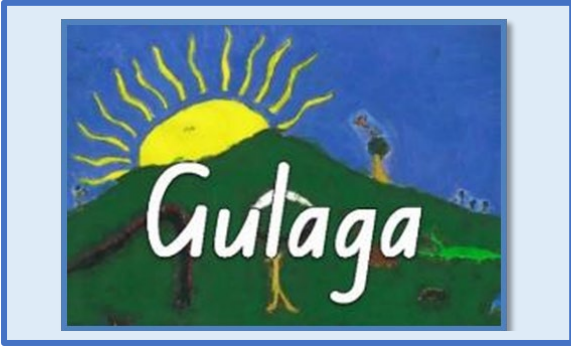
Remembrance Day
