
We will close the survey on Monday 14th October and notify everyone of the outcome in the first newsletter for Term 4 on Friday 18th.

The K12 students look forward to borrowing library books every Friday afternoon.


Some students keep their library books in a special spot at home so they don't misplace them and this also helps them to remember to return them each week.
